Farm Bill Sign Up

It's time to enroll in the Agriculture Risk Coverage (ARC) and Price Loss Coverage (PLC) programs for the 2019 crop year. The deadline for sign up for either program is March 16, 2020.

The 2018 Farm Bill reauthorized and made updates to these two USDA Farm Service Agency (FSA) programs. ARC provides income support payments on historical base acres when actual crop revenue declines below a specified guarantee level. PLC program provides income support payments on historical base acres when the price for a covered commodity falls below its effective reference price.

When you sign up for either program at the FSA office, you will need to provide yield history. Fortunately, the records we keep for your crop insurance coverage at The Roland L. Geyer Agency are acceptable as evidence of yield history for FSA.

Upon your request, The Geyer Agency will provide your yield records then you can make the easy trip to the FSA office, just a few steps from ours.
