Good news for 2026 – your federal crop insurance premiums will be lower. The government increased the share of premium they pay by 3% to 5% so those savings will be passed on to you at the same percentage. Subsidies for some private insurance products increased as well so they may be more affordable. In addition, the Beginning Farmer and Rancher Program also saw improvement with an increase from five to 10 years.

Along with these changes, more have been made to Farm Service Agency programs. The Roland L. Geyer Agency encourages you to check all FSA applications are complete as this will affect eligibility for FSA payments.
