## **JULY 15 DEADLINE: Report Your Planted Acres Early**

Favorable spring weather got planting off to a strong start across the area, with many operations beginning in mid-April. Subsoil moisture levels are encouraging, and like every year, there's plenty of optimism for the growing season ahead.

As you wrap up planting, don't forget your next important step—report your planted acres by July 15, 2026. The sooner you report, the better. Submitting your information to The Roland L. Geyer Agency is simple. Choose the method that works best for you:

### **Important Reminder:**

Your acreage reports submitted to FSA and to The Geyer Agency must match exactly for your crop insurance coverage to remain fully in effect. In the event of a claim, consistent information ensures a smoother, more efficient process.

### **Your Spring To-Do List:**

1. Certify your acres with your county FSA office
2. Provide a copy of your certification to The Roland L. Geyer Agency
3. Enjoy the confidence of knowing your coverage is in place with a team you trust

Reporting early provides peace of mind and helps avoid last-minute stress. Weather is unpredictable, and having your information on file as soon as planting is complete can make a significant difference if issues arise.
